FACTS

- Located at the northern entry to Oregon's Willamette Valley Wine Country, Newberg is home to award-winning wineries, scenic vineyards, and intimate tasting rooms.
- Newberg's walkable downtown features owner-operated restaurants, cafés, locally owned galleries, and shops.
- The city is home to George Fox University, the public arts-devoted Chehalem Cultural Center, and the Hoover-Minthorn House, the only presidential site in Oregon.

AVAS

- Newberg is host to three American Viticultural Areas (AVA), Chehalem Mountains, Ribbon Ridge and Laurelwood. Each AVA has distinct characteristics that are expressed thru climate features and soil profiles which are showcased thru each bottle of wine.



THINGS TO DO

WINE TASTING Newberg is home to a diverse range of acclaimed wineries, offering award-winning Pinot Noir and many other varietals. Enjoy some of Oregon's oldest and most innovative wine producers on an exclusive guided or self-guided tour.

EPICUREAN DELIGHTS Indulge in farm-to-table restaurants, craft breweries, artisanal ice cream makers, independent coffee roasters, tasting rooms and a specialty cheese shop. Food Trails: Follow the Lavender Trail in summer, the Truffle Trail in winter and the Wine Country Whiskey Trail year-round.

ART SCENE Enjoy Newberg's vibrant art scene with local galleries and community events such as Newberg Art Walk, Art Elements Gallery and the Chehalem Cultural Center.

BIKE TOUR Take in breathtaking views of the Chehalem Valley while peddling at a leisurely pace with stops between wineries.

HIKING Traverse Newberg's public trail systems on foot for spectacular Willamette Valley views.

HOT AIR BALLOONING Ascend over the Willamette Valley while you gaze out at the vineyards and rolling hills of wine country, mountain peaks and the river below.

WELLNESS Rejuvenate with Spas, Yoga, Forest Bathing, and relaxing outdoor recreation.

EXPLORE DOWNTOWN Wander through downtown's charming independent boutiques, restaurants, tasting rooms and galleries.

HISTORY AND CULTURE Visit Hoover-Minthorn House and stroll the gardens of the boyhood home of President Herbert Hoover. Take a historic walking tour of George Fox University.

GOLF Chehalem Glenn Golf Course offers 18 holes of the finest golf in Oregon's wine country.

GETTING THERE

Drive time from Portland International Airport is approximately one hour, or 34 miles (54 km). A rental car is recommended.

Over the course of the year, the temperature typically varies from 36°F to 84°F. Summers are warm, dry and mostly clear. Winter can be cold and overcast with possible snow.
